In 1993 I introduced the "GRATE ART" of USA artist Bobbi Mastrangelo to BPCM readers. Bobbi finds the intricate pattern work on manhole covers, beautiful, as indeed some of them are, and incorporates the designs into her environmental art installations and paintings.
