What is New York City? To every visitor and resident, the city is a different world. If you're an artist, the challenge is, how do you capture that vision on paper?

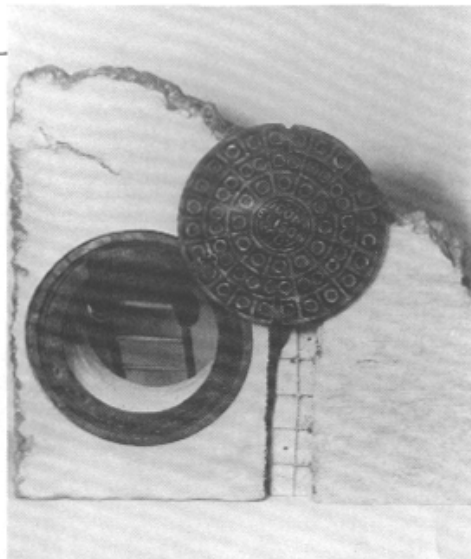
